- Capacity grants close on June 30th – please submit all reimbursement requests by July 31, 2022.

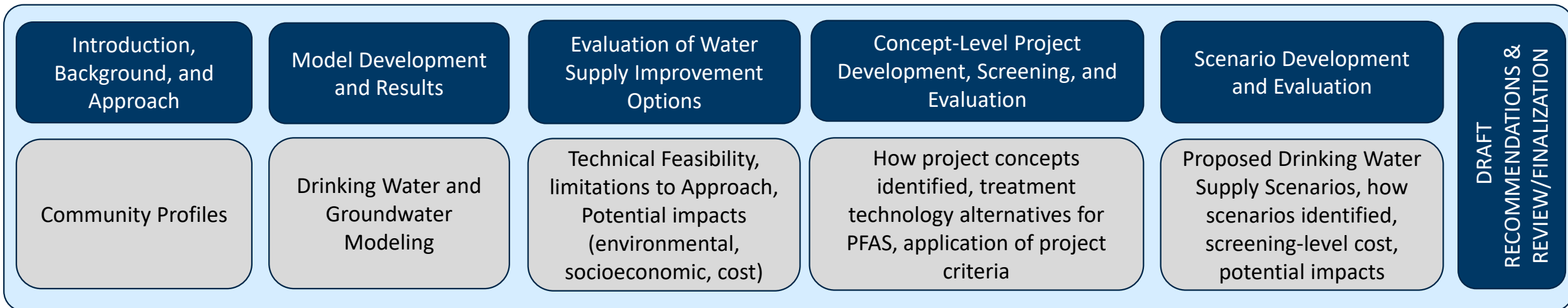

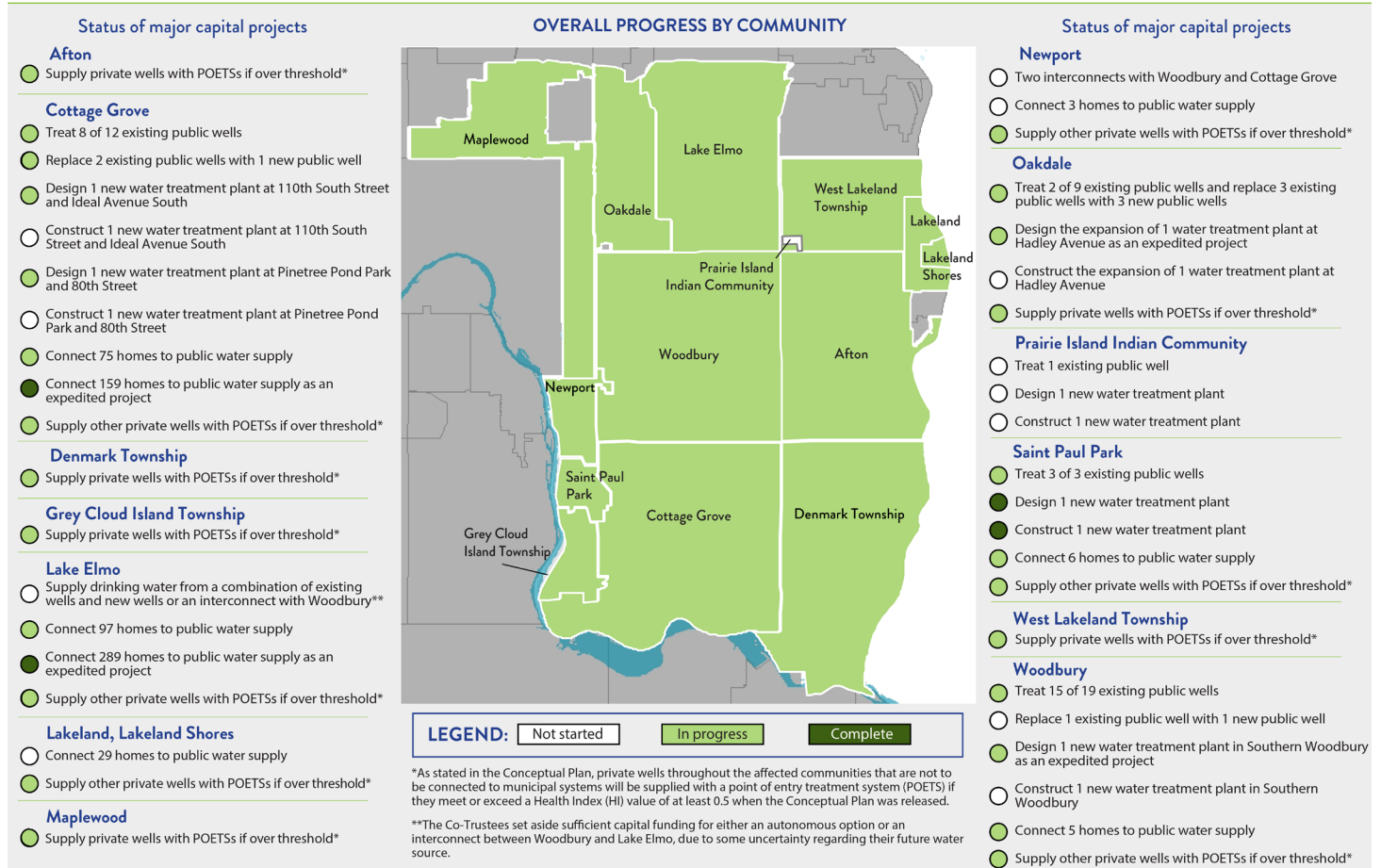
