

Priority 2 Work Group Feedback Summary

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Summary of Feedback Topics

- Fish, wildlife and habitat impacts from PFAS
 - PFAS data were briefly discussed at the June special session and will be the focus of today's meeting. Additional resources were provided with the June meeting materials.
- Fish tissue sampling data in east metro water bodies
 - There is not a comprehensive “report” developed around fish tissue sampling by the interagency sampling group. Links to available data will be provided in the July Feedback Summary and Response.
- Drinking water standards
 - Current state drinking water health-based values are listed on the MDH website. Relevant links were provided with the June meeting materials.
- 3M East Metro remedial actions
 - The June special session reviewed terms of the 2007 consent order and agreement and the 2018 settlement information. Additional resources were provided with the June meeting materials.

Summary of Feedback Topics (cont.)

- Breakdown of 2018 NRDA Settlement funds
 - The breakdown of Settlement funds was discussed during the June special session and provided with the June meeting materials.
- Investment planning and revenue from interest
 - \$720 million was available to implement projects that meet the Settlement goals; investment strategies differed by priority and were described during the June special session and meeting materials.
- Communication strategy
 - DNR and MPCA will develop a comprehensive communications plan for the Priority 2 RFP closer to the release date (currently scheduled for early 2024).
- Natural resource restoration efforts examples
 - The focus of Priority 2 planning is to develop a process that identifies projects that would most effectively restore the natural resource injuries and service losses that have occurred due to the release of PFAS released by 3M. Additional resources were provided with the June meeting materials.
