# Next Steps

- Continue reviewing grant forms and implementing community projects
  - Evaluate Priority 1 funds as community projects are implemented
- Continue resampling private wells and communicating with residents about the need for private well testing
- Continue installing whole-home treatment systems in homes that have well advisories

# Meeting with local governments regarding POETs

Department of Labor and Industry requires permit/inspections for POETS

MPCA meeting with local governments to share information

- Prepare to send Community Survey in June:
  - Confirm timeline of existing grants
  - Estimate timing and costs for future planning and design grants
  - Estimate timing and costs for future construction grants
  - Estimate timing and cost for Operations and Maintenance grants
  - Estimate timing for decommissioning of temporary treatment facilities

- Fall 2025 work group meeting
  - Track progress on project implementation
  - Discuss status of reallocations
  - Compare actual costs to plan estimates
  - Continue discussions on future reallocation with work group members
  - Update on mediation between CoTrustees and 3M Company

## Timeline:

March 2025: RFP letter of intent for qualification screening | Q&A Opportunity

Summer 2025: Full RFP opens for projects that passed screening

Summer 2025: Public grant application workshop

Fall 2025: Full RFP grant application due

Early 2026: Applicants notified, and contracts initiated

2026: Projects begin
