#### Purpose

- The Co-Trustees will be holding three rounds of public meetings over the next few months on the Conceptual Drinking Water Supply Plan (CDWSP)
- The purpose of this agenda item is to present the planned public feedback process and receive work group input on the proposed process

# February planned activities

#### Key dates and community engagement

- February 11: Preliminary scenario results (i.e., modeling results without criteria evaluation or good/better/best recommendations) emailed to work groups
- February 18-19: Review preliminary scenario results at work group meetings. Ask local cable to record meeting and post video on website
- Feb 24-28: Host six informational and listening sessions to present preliminary scenario results. Engagement questions:
  - Do you live or work in the impacted area?
  - Do you have a private well? If so, how do you feel about connecting to a public water system?
  - How do you feel about utilizing an alternative water supply (e.g., surface water) without PFAS contamination?
  - How much money should be set aside for PFAS-related long-term operations and maintenance (O&M) costs? For how many years?
  - Are there other Priority 1 projects (e.g., drinking water, sustainability, conservation) you have in mind?
  - What do you see is the biggest benefit of this plan (what is right with this plan)?

## March planned activities

#### Key dates and community engagement

- March: Co-Trustees evaluate scenarios using the Priority 1 criteria and determine good/better/best recommendations
- March 17-18: Work group meetings
  - Discuss feedback from February's informational and listening sessions on the preliminary scenario results
- March April: Co-Trustees meet with LGU's to discuss good/better/best recommendations

## April planned activities

#### Key dates and community engagement

- March April: Co-Trustees meet with LGU's to discuss good/better/best recommendations
- Early April: Release draft CDWSP (with good/better/best recommendations) to the work groups and Subgroup 1
- April 14-15: Work group meetings
  - Discuss work group feedback on draft CDWSP (including good/better/best recommendations)
- April 14: Release draft CDWSP (with good/better/best recommendations) to the public and formally request public input
- April 14 May 14: Request public input via SurveyGizmo. Engagement questions:
  - Did you attend an informational session in February?
  - Do you have an impacted water supply?
  - Do you have any thoughts/concerns with the CDWSP?
  - Seeing the costs for O&M, are you comfortable with what is planned to be set aside for the future?
  - What do you see is the biggest benefit of this plan (what is right with this plan)?
- End of April: Host two public meetings to share good/better/best recommendations

### May 2020 and beyond

- Finalize CDWSP
- Develop final decision
- Host public meetings on final decision
- Enter into funding agreements
