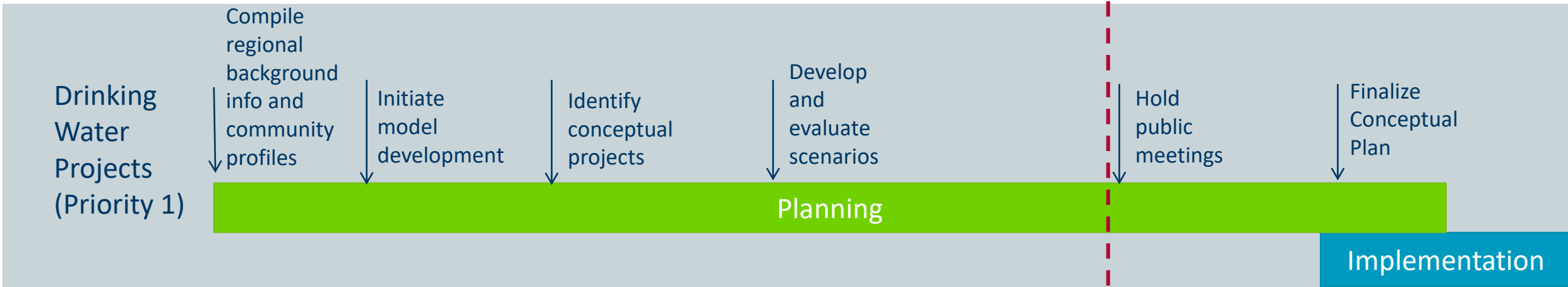
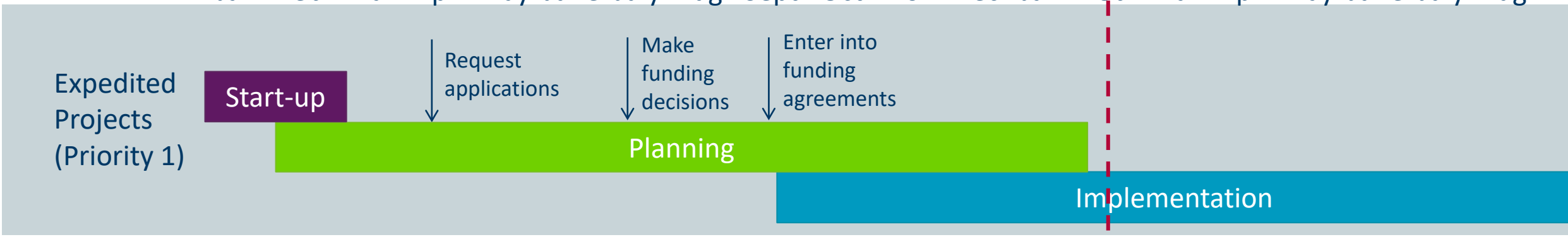

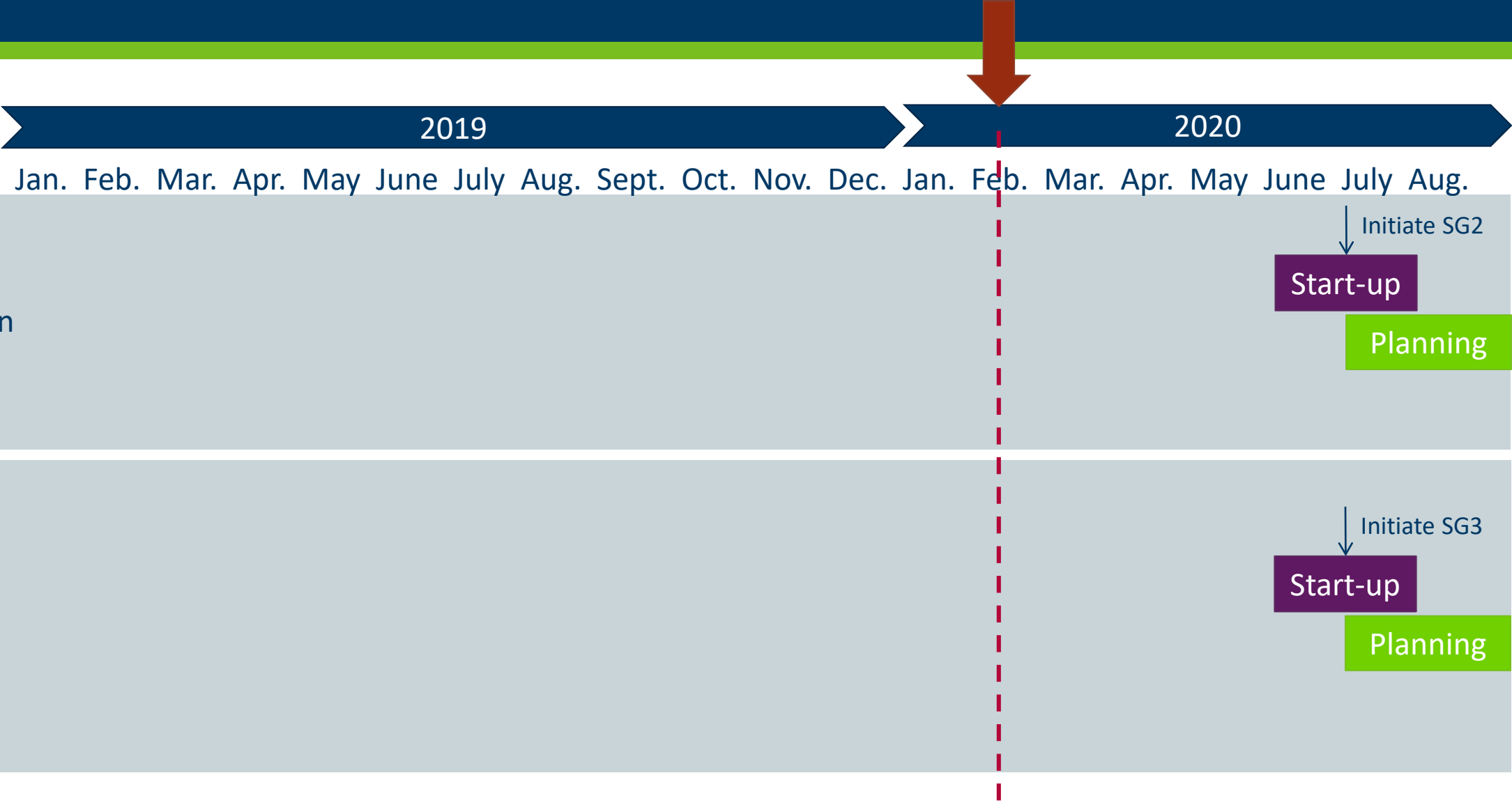
High-Level Timeline
